TASTING NOTES

Our 2009 Rosé is a classic Southern Rhône Valley-style blend of 60% Grenache, 34% Syrah and 6% Mourvèdre. It offers lovely, fresh-as-can-be aromas of watermelon, strawberry and red raspberry complemented by delightful scents of tangerine blossom and cracked pepper. On the dry, full-bodied, beautifully balanced palate, rich, creamy, raspberry and pepper flavors lead to a long, mouthwatering finish bolstered by a crisp mineral tone characteristic of our limestone-rich Westside Paso Robles vineyard. A delightful aperitif, this world-class rosé also is delicious with herb-roasted chicken, grilled salmon, summer salads and baguette and cheese. Enjoy it over the next 1-2 years.
