TASTING NOTES

The 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon possesses excellent balance with aromatics of dark fruits and cherry pie. Bright and rich on the palate, this wine is brimming with flavors of blackberries, red currants and cassis. Well integrated tannins guide this wine through a long, seamless finish. Delicious now with grilled steak and lamb, prime rib, and other hearty meat dishes, it will continue to develop for another 7-10 years.
