## OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU!

- We are thrilled to be able to welcome you back to Halter Ranch. You will notice we have made some changes in order to comply with CDC guidelines and our own high standards for health and safety.
  - In compliance with state guidelines, all tastings and food and wine experiences will be outdoors.
  - Reservations are required.
  - To ensure a safe distance between guests, we will be operating under limited capacity. Enjoy outdoor seating spaced 6 feet apart in our beautiful Tasting Room.
  - In between each reservation, our team will clean and sanitize guest areas and Tasting Room menus.
  - We will frequently sanitize high touch surfaces such a door handles, hand railings, etc.
  - Our team will be wearing face masks, and we ask that you do too whenever not seated or standing at the bar.
  - We require our employees to do daily wellness checks, including temperature readings, before they arrive on property. Employees are required to stay home and get the proper care if they, or anyone in their household, show symptoms of cough, shortness of breath, fever, etc.
  - We have provided multiple sanitation stations for your use. Our team will be washing and sanitizing their hands frequently and thoroughly throughout your visit.
  - Our team will be practicing social distancing, maintaining at least 6 feet apart, and we ask that you do the same.

## PLAN YOUR VISIT.

- Start by making a reservation! We offer three types of reservations for groups no larger than 6 people; this includes non-tasters. We ask that Tasting Room guests be 21 and over.
  - You will have the choice between the following reservation-only experiences:
    1. A tasting-only reservation either standing at your own bar in the Tasting Room or seated on the Tasting Room Patio.
    2. A lunch reservation with wine served by the glass and bottle.
    3. A table reservation for bottle service on the Tasting Room patio.
- For your protection and the protection of all our guests and staff, we ask that you abide by the following rules during your visit:
  - We can't wait to welcome you back with open arms; however, we ask that guests refrain from handshakes and hugging and maintain the appropriate social distance between other households as well as staff.
  - We require our guests to wear masks upon entrance and exit of the Tasting Room as well when walking around the property. Single-use masks will be available. Masks can be removed once you are seated and ready to enjoy your meal or tasting.
  - We encourage you to use the multiple sanitation stations around the Tasting Room.
  - If you have been exposed to COVID-19 recently or have symptoms of COVID-19 (including a fever, cough, or shortness of breath), please help us keep everyone safe by staying home and receiving the proper care!
