TASTING NOTES

Petit Verdot is one of the six red grape varietals that are allowed to be grown in Bordeaux, France, and its name loosely translates to "little green one" a reference to its late ripening behavior. Petit Verdot thrives in warm climates, and although it is traditionally used in small amounts for blending, in 2016 we had some exceptional vineyard blocks of Petit Verdot that were just so good we decided to bottle a limited production on its own. Petit Verdot is known for its color, structure and tannins, and this wine lives up to these attributes. This offering has aromas of black cherry, blackberries and butterscotch that lead to flavors of licorice and sarsaparilla.

Enjoy this wine with roasted lamb dishes, barbecued short ribs or hold meats.

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
